2009 Deux Chevaux Vineyard **Chardonnay**

Tamber Bey's estate-grown Dijon Clone Chardonnay is a unique wine for Napa. This Chardonnay has a 'Burgundian' feel as the French Dijon clone brings a wonderful mid-pallet sense of fruit, but leaves out the oak and butter (characteristic of traditional Napa Chardonnays). This 'ol block of Chardonnay just keeps giving us the amazing fruit.

Winemaker Notes:

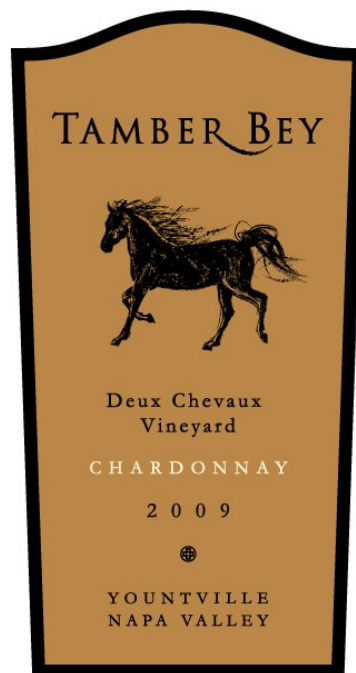
2009 was our latest harvest to date for our Dijon clone block of Estate Chardonnay. This hang time allowed the fruit to eloquently achieve ripeness, which produced a wine of many layers and complexities. At first glance there is a vibrant golden hue. Scents of Meyer lemon, Asian pear, tropical notes and spices of the East soar from the glass when swirled. These notes glide effortlessly over a rich and silky mid palate that is buttressed by ample natural acidity. The interaction between richness and verve is the hallmark of this wine and it displays that incredibly with the interplay of Crème Brulee and ripe citrus notes and a long, lingering finish.

Deux Chevaux Vineyard

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, north-east of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for "two horses," the namesake of Tamber Bey.

About Tamber Bey

Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated winery that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte's first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey).
