2009 Deux Chevaux Vineyard **Tovero**

Tamber Bey's estate-grown Petit Verdot based Bordeaux Blend wine, Tovero, is a powerful blend that exhibits the unique traits of the Deux Chevaux Vineyard: a strong base of Petit Verdot and the aromatics of Cabernet Franc, finished off with a trace of Cabernet Sauvignon. Planted in 2002, the 2009 vintage of this wine is the first release of this wine.

Winemaker Notes:

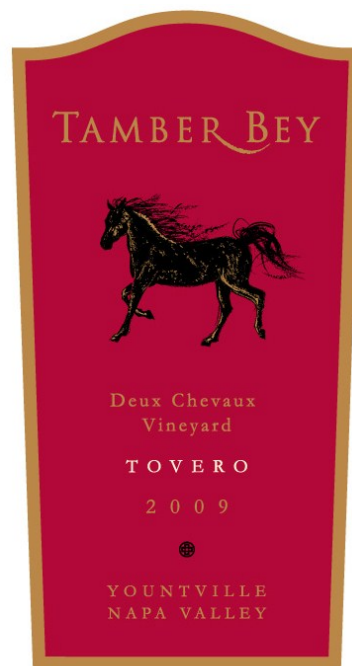
The 2009 vintage blessed us with some incredible fruit to work with to make this unique blend of Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon. Immediately, your eyes are taken by its dark purple color and clarity. The aromatics consist of dark fruits, lead pencil, forest floor and mulled cherries. True to its Petit Verdot roots, lush and floral fruit components fold into a mid palate that echoes the above notes and introduces spice box and minerality. The complex finish combines nuances from all three varietals, bringing this wine to its feet with supple tannins; rich, spice-laden fruit; and perfect acidity. A few years of bottle age will further integrate this wine, and a long decant time will allow it to open up for near-term consumption. This wine will show its best with 3 to 4 years of age and will age gracefully for up to 10 years or more.

Deux Chevaux Vineyard

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, north-east of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for “two horses,” the namesake of Tamber Bey.

About Tamber Bey

Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated winery that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte's first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey).
