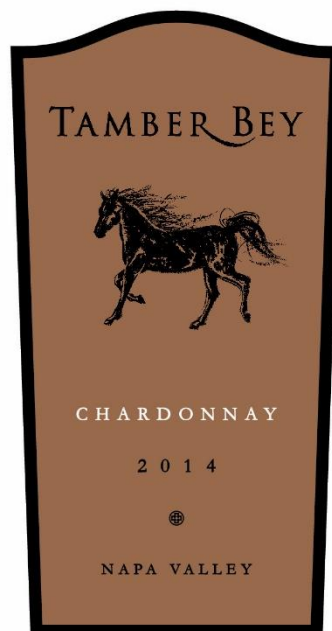

2014 Napa Valley **Chardonnay**

This wine is produced from the same Dijon Chardonnay Clone that is in the renowned Deux Chevaux Vineyard Chardonnay. Fermented and aged in a combination of stainless steel and French oak, this wine delivers incredible brightness and freshness.

Winemaker Notes

The nose delivers a mix of dry apricot, vanilla, sweet oak, Juicy Fruit gum and a bit of delicate orange blossom. A medium-bodied Chardonnay, but still unctuous in texture. The flavors are dominated at first by vanilla custard, butterscotch, and a hint of orange marmalade and lime that evolve in the finish into creamy dulce de leche notes.

Deux Chevaux Vineyard

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, northeast of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Malbec. Deux Chevaux is French for “two horses,” the namesake of Tamber Bey.

About Tamber Bey

Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated winery that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte’s first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey).
