2015 Chardonnay - Dijon Deux Chevaux Vineyard, Yountville AVA

Tamber Bey's estate-grown Dijon Clone Chardonnay is a unique wine for Napa. This Chardonnay has a 'Burgundian' feel as the French Dijon clone brings a wonderful mid-pallet sense of fruit, but leaves out the oak and butter (characteristic of traditional Napa Chardonnays). This old block of Chardonnay just keeps giving us the amazing fruit.

Wine Enthusiast – 91 Points

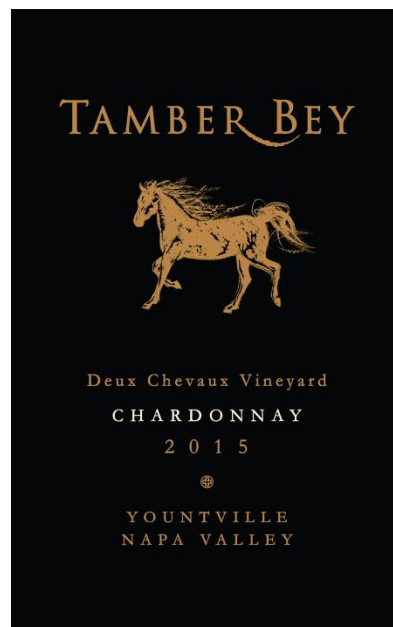
Made entirely from Dijon clones to emphasize the fruit from this site, this wine is voluptuous in style, with a backbone of caramelized apple and pear flavor. Fig and quince contribute secondary characteristics of rounded richness, as a bite of salty lime marks the finish. - VB

Winemaker Notes

The 2015 'Dijon' Chardonnay delivers a rich nose that is dominated by butterscotch aromas mixed with notes of coconut shavings, vanilla and Mandarin custard. The mouth is rich and full-bodied, mixing buttery flavors with caramel and orange blossom. Notes of dry hazelnut linger in the long finish.

Deux Chevaux Vineyard

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, north-east of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for "two horses," the namesake of Tamber Bey.
