Andy Jones - Winemaker Notes

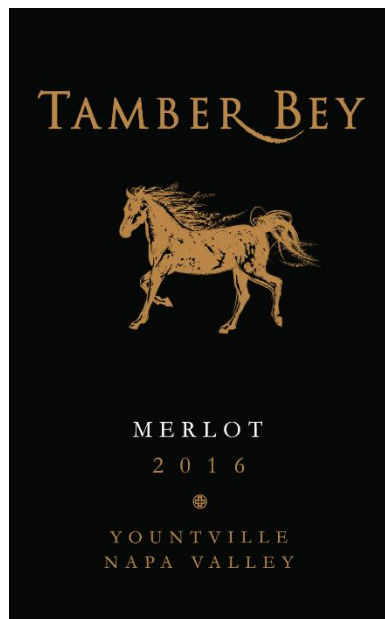
A classic Merlot. This aromatic, fruit-forward wine delivers a core of black fruit, with black currant and notes of chocolate. It is full-bodied, with a well-integrated texture and velvety tannins.

Deux Chevaux Vineyard

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, northeast of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for "two horses," the namesake of Tamber Bey.

About Tamber Bey

Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated business that produces wine from its two estate-owned vineyards in the heart of the Napa Valley: the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation. Tamber Bey also produces wines with sourced fruit from seven premium vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and Lake counties. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte's first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey). The winery is located in Calistoga, Ca.
