Tamber Bey's original wine with a 50 case first release in 2001 (then called Red Wine), this wine is a classic Napa style of Cabernet with a richness and well balanced approachable elegance.

Winemaker Notes

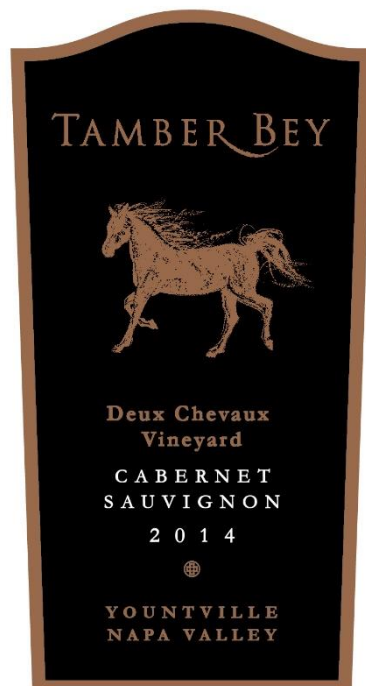
Deep cassis and black cherry dominate the nose, with secondary aromas of crushed stones and light blond tobacco. A sweet burst of black fruit introduces the mouth, followed by notes of blackberry sauce and cassis, with a touch of sweet vanilla. The finish delivers dark stone fruit, with an earthy note and a hint of coffee bean.

Deux Chevaux Vineyard

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, northeast of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for "two horses," which is the namesake of Tamber Bey.

About Tamber Bey

With a winery located in Calistoga at the Sundance Ranch, Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation, as well as sourced fruit from seven premium vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and Lake counties. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte's first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey).
