2014 Deux Chevaux Vineyard **Chardonnay**

Tamber Bey's estate-grown Dijon Clone Chardonnay is a unique wine for Napa. This Chardonnay has a 'Burgandian' feel as the French Dijon clone brings a wonderful mid-pallet sense of fruit, but leaves out the oak and butter (characteristic of traditional Napa Chardonnays). This old block of Chardonnay just keeps giving us the amazing fruit.

Winemaker Notes:

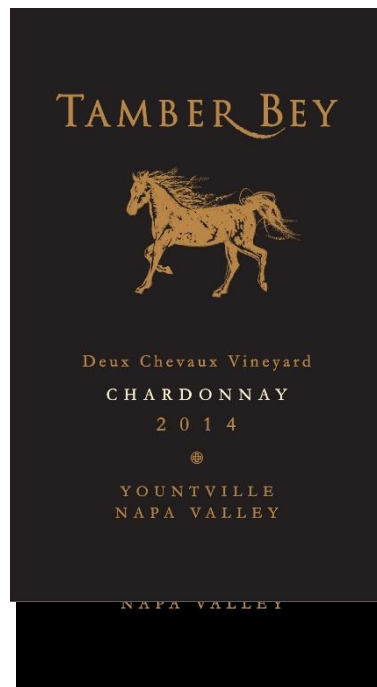
This wine delivers a very rich nose that mixes brioche, candied peach and white chocolate. The mouthfeel is full-bodied, with a creamy texture that is the result of the barrel fermentation and lees stirring. Flavors include salted caramel, white flowers and a little bit of nutmeg spice. The wine finishes with long notes of fresh pear, hazelnut and white peach.

Deux Chevaux Vineyard

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, north-east of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for "two horses," the namesake of Tamber Bey.

About Tamber Bey

Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated winery that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte's first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey).
