## 2014 Vermejo

### Deux Chevaux Vineyard, Yountville AVA

This is the inaugural release of our Signature Collection full Bordeaux blend from our Deux Chevaux Vineyard. Made in a true best of barrel program, this wine delivers a rich and wide flavor that one wine can have that is represented by five different varietals.

#### *Winemaker Notes*

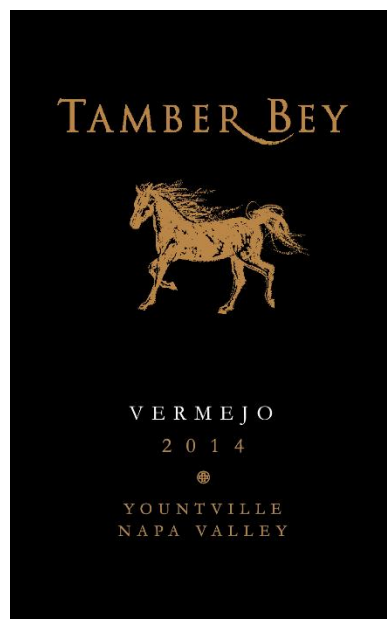
The 2014 Vermejo delivers aromas of black and blue fruits (blackberry, blackberry pie and black cherry), followed by mineral notes of wet stone and ash, a hint of raw beef, lavender and cedar notes, and a touch of light smoked paprika. This is a full-body wine, showing great juiciness, with ample dark, fleshy stone fruit flavors that are complemented by earthy notes. The wine has nice, firm tannins that are a trademark of the vintage. The finish is a mix of beautiful graphite, sweet oak and cigar box flavors.

#### *Deux Chevaux Vineyard*

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, northeast of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for “two horses,” the namesake of Tamber Bey.

#### *About Tamber Bey*

With a winery located in Calistoga at the Sundance Ranch, Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation, as well as sourced fruit from seven premium vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and Lake counties. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte's first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey).
