Winemaker Notes

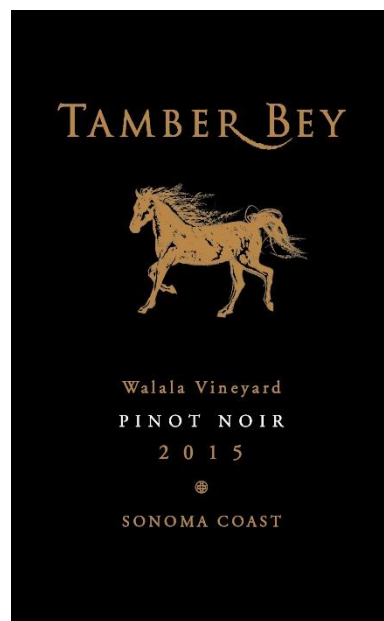
This is our first release of Pinot Noir from the Walala Vineyard on the Sonoma Coast. The nose is elegant, with aromas of mocha complemented by a burst of bright red berries. This is a lighter, more fruit-forward style of Pinot Noir. The mouth is packed with raspberry and grenadine, with a light undertone of cedar. The long finish delivers tea and rose hips.

Walala Vineyard

Walala comes from the Kashaya Pomo Indian saying, "where the water flows down," a reference to the local Gualala River and nearby town of Gualala, which resides at the mouth of the Gualala River. This heavily maritime-influenced vineyard is on the extreme edge of Pinot Noir viticulture. A 17-acre vineyard, Walala lies in the middle of 19,000 acres of pristine forestland, where at the 1,200 feet, a world-class Pinot Noir is produced. Goldridge fine, sandy loam and gravelly Hugo loam soils comprise this well-drained vineyard estate.

About Tamber Bey

With a winery located in Calistoga at the Sundance Ranch, Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation, as well as sourced fruit from seven premium vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and Lake counties.
