### Deux Chevaux Vineyard, Yountville AVA

Tamber Bey's estate-grown Bordeaux-blend wine, Rabicano (pronounced Rab-i-kawno), is a masterful blend that exhibits the unique traits of the Deux Chevaux Vineyard, a strong core of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot with the bolstering power of Petit Verdot and the aromatics of Cabernet Franc. Planted in 2002, This was Tamber Bey's original blend that inspired three other blends: Sabino, Tovero and Vermejo.

### *James Suckling – 94 Points*

The blueberry and stone aromas are intense. Full body, round and chewy tannins and a polished, silky finish. A blend of cabernet sauvignon, merlot, cabernet franc, petit verdot and malbec. Drink in 2020.

### *Winemaker Notes*

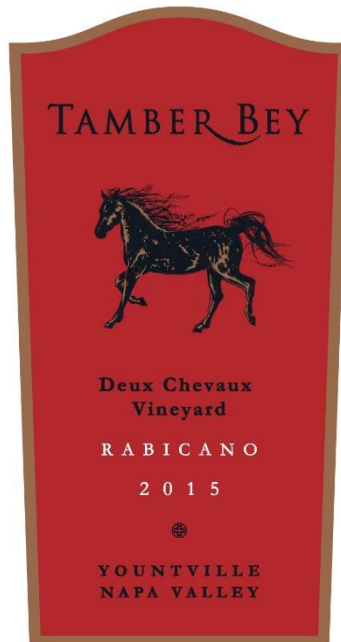
The fragrant nose delivers aromas of fresh-baked cherry pie and cookie dough combined with baked rhubarb, black tea and cedar notes. The mouthfeel is seamless in texture from beginning to finish. Juicy black pitted fruit evolves into a finish of cigar box notes.

### *Deux Chevaux Vineyard*

The Deux Chevaux Vineyard is a 60-acre vineyard situated in the Yountville Appellation, northeast of the town of Yountville. The vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Chardonnay. Deux Chevaux is French for “two horses,” the namesake of Tamber Bey.
