Oakville Estate Vineyard, Oakville AVA

Our original Signature Collection wine, originally released in 2002, this Cabernet is all about the Oakville AVA. The fruit is from the Oakville Estate Vineyard. The dense, cane-pruned vines deliver the full impact of the Oakville soil into the body of this wine.

Winemaker Notes


On the nose, black cherry mixes with wet stone and a lingering scent of cedar. On the palate, the wine has a full body and velvety texture with silky tannins. Black stone fruits evolve into floral notes, a hint of bitter chocolate and mocha. While this wine is approachable early, its richness, tannin structure and balanced acidity will allow it to age gracefully for years to come.

Oakville Estate Vineyard

The Tamber Bey Oakville Estate is located at the southern end of Napa Valley's famous Oakville appellation, just north of Yountville. It has gravel/loam soils that are relatively shallow and well suited to Cabernet. The site enjoys early morning fog and late afternoon breezes influenced by the San Francisco Bay to the south. To encourage competition for sun, water and nutrients, Tamber Bey planted more than 9,500 vines in a tight planting formation on 3 acres.

About Tamber Bey

With a winery located in Calistoga at the Sundance Ranch, Tamber Bey is a family-owned and operated that produces wine from its two estate owned vineyards at the heart of the Napa Valley, the Estate Vineyard in the Oakville Appellation and the Deux Chevaux Vineyard in the Yountville Appellation, as well as sourced fruit from seven premium vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and Lake counties. The name Tamber Bey reflects the names of owner Barry Waitte's first two Arabian endurance horses, Tamborina (Tamber) and Bayamo (Bey).
